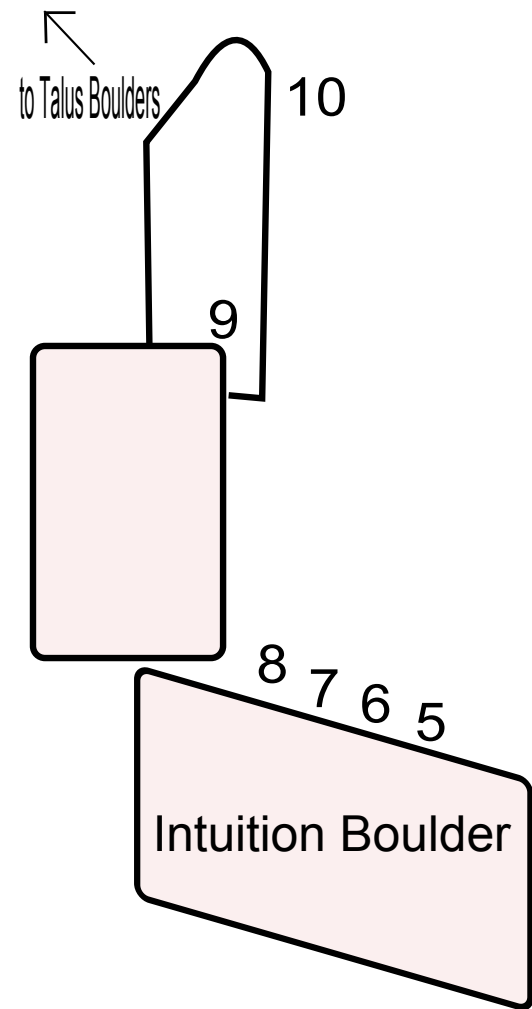
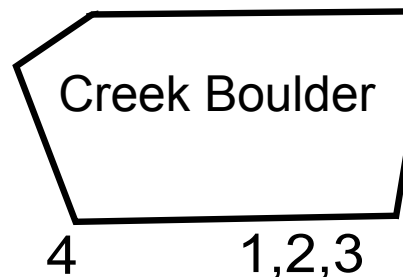


MYSTIC BOULDERS



1. Sting Like A Scorpion (v4) *** - sit start on sloping skirt with two sloping crimps. Climb straight up
2. Werewolf Bar Mitzvah (v4) *** - start same as 1, traverse left along skirt, topping out on 4.
3. Winter Of Our Discotheque (v6) **** - start same as 2, but at arete keep moving left to shallow, sloping crack. Match the crack, then continue left to good jugs, then top out.
4. Christian's Arete (v1) ** - Climb straight up SW arete.
5. Have A Gneiss Journey (v1+) **** - Start with two crimos at chest height, then bump up right to bulge. Continue moving up and right all the way to the top of the boulder. Classic.
6. Oh, That's My Spoon (v3/4) *** - Alternate start to 5. Start left hand on incut sidepull crimp, left on sloper sidepull. Heel hook sloper sidepull, thow up to good crimp, then up to bulge. Continue as for 5.
7. Project - Start matched on good undercling, with poor and scrunched up feet. Throw left to good gaston, then up to bulge. Top out straight up or as for 5.
8. Reaching For Forever (v3) **** - Stand start and reach for a right hand pinch and left hand crimp. Find a foot or campus up to good left hand block. Get a left foot, then throw up to a good right hand incut. Set your feet, and throw for the lip, topout.
9. Arete Proj - Not so much a hard project, but trying to summon the courage is the crux. Use boulder below to gain the arete. Work up arete a little, then throw for the lip.
10. Project - difficult and crimpy line following he underside of an overhanging prow. Real nice.

11. Hide My Thunder (v2) ** - Sit start on west side, throw to dish, then top out straight up
12. Mrs. Feathebottom (v1) * - Climb up just right of SW arete on polished bulges
13. Slabdyno (v1) ** - Get good left hand undercling, right on arete. Get balanced, throw for lip.

14. Losers Luck (v3) * - NW arete of Red Beauty
15. Golden Spike (v1) ** - Climb cool spike in middle of boulder. Would be classic if it was taller.
